Alphi Chugh, learned counsel for accused no. 1 and 2 has also appeared in the proceedings and he has informed that he has to take necessary instructions from his clients within one week and would try to furnish written arguments by the next date of hearing. Since counsel for accused no. 1 and 2 has submitted that he has not got any instructions from his clients as they are out of station, let notice be issued to accused no. 1 and 2 informing them to appear in the proceedings by video conference giving details of email ID of the court as well as Cisco Webex application etc.

Put up now this case on 16.06.2020 at 2.00 PM for appearance of counsel for accused no. 1 and 2 and to furnish his written arguments after taking written instructions from his clients. It is being clarified that if the courts start functioning after 14.06.2020, this matter will be taken up in the court otherwise proceedings will be taken up by video conference.
