Respected Sir/Madam,

It is to inform that a letter dated 22.04.2025 was received from Hon'ble High Court of Delhi regarding weekly report on New Criminal Laws, 2023. Vide aforesaid letter, a copy of letter of Director, CDTI, Ghaziabad alongwith copy of DO letter dated 25.07.2024 of the Union Home Secretary, Govt. of India was forwarded to the Academy for providing the requisite information pertaining to the training in New Criminal Laws by the Delhi Judicial Academy.
